ABOUT AAAFF

Austin Asian American Film Festival (AAAFF) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that programs year-round community events, highlighted by its flagship annual festival each June. Since 2004, the organization has grown from a single showcase event run by volunteers to one of the only cultural arts nonprofits supporting Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander (AANHPI) communities in the Austin, TX area.

WHAT SUPPORTING AAAFF MEANS

THE IMPORTANCE OF REPRESENTATION

AAAFF believes that although the movies and media we consume often perpetuate stereotypes and render marginalized groups invisible, cinema also has the potential to empower the under-represented and promote cross-cultural understanding.

For more than a decade, AAAFF has presented films from over 28 countries and brought dozens of filmmakers, actors, and documentary subjects to Austin to share their experiences, and we're excited to continue our community screenings, annual film festival and expand our filmmaker programs. With each film screened, we often partner with local community groups to better amplify the reach of films so that the communities represented in the film or behind the camera are also present at our screenings.

ANNUAL FILM FESTIVAL

Our Annual film festival June 21-25, 2023 will be back at local indie movie theater AFS Cinema! We're upgrading to 5 days of film this year! For this fest, we showcase new and emerging works by AANHPI filmmakers for a juried festival that includes screenings, filmmaker Q&As, and events that celebrate film!



CO-PRESENTATIONS



AAAFF's reputation as the premiere AAPI cultural arts organization in Austin is made possible by our many partners in film programming. From retrospectives to special screenings of Asian and Asian American film, our partners organizations range from Austin Film Society, Indie Meme, All Genders and Lifestyles Film Festival, Austin Jewish Film Festival Mobile Loaves & Fishes Outdoor Cinema, North American API Film Festivals Coalition, the Long Center, Sound Unseen and more!

STORIES WITHIN

Our first fiscal sponsored project, STORIES WITHIN is both a mini-documentary series and movement created to change the narrative of AAPI in Texas. Directed by award-winning documentary filmmaker PJ Raval and created by Austin-based creatives, this project was selected to be in the first cohort of the Gold Futures Challenge. Along with the short films, has been on a film festival run & hosted a Premiere & AAPI Storytelling Summit at Austin Central Library.

FILM INDUSTRY PROGRAMS

ASIAN PACIFIC FILMMAKERS EXPERIENCE

AAAFF partners with the Asian Pacific Filmmakers Experience to host events and panels with AANHPI filmmakers during the SXSW Film Festival. In 2022 & 2023, we partnered with Kollaboration, David Magdael PR, Visual Communications, Coalition of Asian Pacifics in Entertainment (CAPE), Asian American Documentary Network, and Center for Asian American Media to put on filmmaker industry events that garnered over 300 attendees.



In 2022 special guests included Oscar-winning actor Ke Huy Quan and producer Jonathan Wang from the film EVERYTHING EVERYWHERE ALL AT ONCE, which was the headlining film for the SXSW Film Festival.

YEAR-ROUND ADVOCACY & NETWORKING



We couldn't do our work without a robust local Film Community! Throughout the year, we represent and share the needs of our filmmakers to elected officials, government bodies, and commissions that fund artists. In 2022 we held a focus group with Austin Arts Commissioners and filmmakers to learn about their funding needs. Throughout the year we host filmmaking networking mixers & workshops.

FREE COMMUNITY SCREENINGS

Accessible and affordable opportunities to watch AANHPI films are especially important to us as we continue to bring AANHPI films to the local community. In 2021 & 2022, we partnered with A24 for a free screenings of the award-winning films MINARI & EVERYTHING EVERYWHERE ALL AT ONCE, including special free screenings prioritizing AANHPI serving direct service workers.

We outreach to AANHPI-serving groups such as Asian Family Support Services of Austin, Asian American Community Health Initiative, Greater Austin Asian American Chamber of Commerce, and specific cultural organizations to ensure the AAPI communities represented in films actually get the chance to watch them.

BUILDING COMMUNITY

THE AAAFF AUDIENCE





Our recent survey data shows that our audience is primarily AANHPI young professionals who value us as a connector to their cultural communities. Key findings include:

- >70% identify as AANHPI
- >50% are aged 25-44 and the gender demographic is relatively equal
- Within AANHPI, 80% identify with Austin's top AANHPI groups (Chinese, Indian, Vietnamese, Korean, Filipino), and the remaining 20% indicate a wide spread of smaller Austin metro AANHPI demographics
- The main driver for attendees to engage with AAAFF is "connecting with AANHPI community" over watching film, supporting local filmmakers, and connections to the org
- >90% very likely or extremely likely to recommend us to family & friends
